# FINAL SITE CHECKLIST

### DEADLINE:

Post your completed site to the FTP

E-mail me your index page URL before next class. Do not change this URL if you continue to finesse the site.

### SITE REVIEW/MAINTENANCE

An ongoing development phase of most web sites is maintenance. Once it is built and uploaded to the host server a web designer will be asked to develop new content as well as update existing content. You will also be asked to fix bugs, perform hardware and software updates and consult with an employer or client about best practices, ongoing opportunities and more. For your final project make sure your site has all the content in place and is working without bugs or broken links. Check the spelling, grammar, and alignment of all content. Make sure you have the correct page titles on each page!

Any content links outside of your site, or different in look and feel needs to have a \_blank target applied to open in a new window.

### INDEX.HTML (HOME PAGE)

- Slide graphics that link to different content areas in your site these can be the same as the page graphics but a different size.
- Page graphics and text that link to different content areas in your site with introduction text that relates to the image.

### ABOUT.HTML

- Professional bio or quirky bio (*it is up to you*) with a photo or self portrait.
- Another text entry that tells a story about you, or is an observation with a supporting visual
- Sidebar (*This can be the same on each page OR you can customize the links and boxed text area to relate to the content on your about page.*)

### GALLERY.HTML

- Text, images and links to: banner project; type exploration; and motion/animation project.
- Link to horizontal banners page (*NOTE: You do not have to include all your banners. It can be just a few representational banners for each format.*)
- Link to vertical banners page.
- Link to animated banner page.
- Link to motion page.
- Link to motion hover page
- Sidebar (*This can be the same on each page OR you can customize the links and boxed text area to relate to the content on your gallery page.*)

### RESOURCES.HTML

#### COLOR RELATIONSHIPS

- Links and image to your color relationships mini site – 7 pages including the color home page. (*NOTE: Make sure you have a relative link back to your resources.html page on each page.*)

#### TYPOGRAPHY EXERCISES

- Links and image to your typography exercises (*6 pages*)
  1. Words
  2. Bibliography
  3. @Font-Face Bibliography
  4. Google Fonts Bibliography
- Minimum of 3 links of your choice to outside design resources (*Typography, color, css, etc.*)
- Written site review of any design site and link to site.
