HW1: HALFTONES

WORKING WITH HALFTONES

Download the file **HW1.ZIP** from the class Bb. Inside this zipped file you will find three image files. Following the specs below create the image as indicated using Photoshop.

Having problems remembering what was done in class? Please refer to the ART265-CEx-Halftones handout.

PHOTO 1: CREATING HALFTONES



Use the image GT-Forest.jpg. Rename file so that it includes your last name (GT-Forest-lastname.jpg). In Photoshop, resample the image so that it is 300 dpi, and convert image color mode to grayscale. Remember to adjust image in the curves or levels windows to adjust the levels of black, gray and white.

Once this is done save the file and create the following halftone documents:

- Halftone Pattern
- Silhouette (use an organic shape)
- Halftone Dropout
- Vignette
- Duotone (chose 2 PMS colors)
- Halftone Dropout

PHOTO 2: HALFTONE COMBO 1



Did you know that the halftone techniques can be combined?

Use the image GT-Jellyfish.jpg. Rename so that it includes your last name (GT-Jellyfish-lastname.jpg). In Photoshop, resample the image so that it is 300 dpi. Convert image color mode to grayscale. Remember to adjust image in the curves or levels windows to adjust the levels of black, gray and white.

Once this is done save le and create a halftone that has all of the following in one document:

- Duotone (black and 1 PMS)
- Silhouette

PHOTO 2: HALFTONE COMBO 2



Use the image GT-Campfire.jpg. Rename so that it includes your last name (GT-Campfire-lastname.jpg).

In Photoshop, resample the image so that it is 300 dpi, and convert image color mode to grayscale. Remember to adjust image in the curves or levels windows to adjust the levels of black, gray and white.

Once this is done save file and create a grayscale halftone that has all of the following in one document:

- Halftone Pattern
- Duotone (black and 1 PMS)
- Vignette

SUBMITTING FINAL FILES
